This Thursday, September 28th, the Catholic Church will celebrate the feast day of San Lorenzo Ruiz, the patron saint of the Philippines. In the 17th century, San Lorenzo and his companions were martyred during a Japanese persecution of Christians. San Lorenzo willingly died rather than recant his faith in Christ. San Lorenzo is the protomartyr and first saint of the Philippines.

Today, the Filipino Community of St. Mary's will celebrate San Lorenzo Ruiz with a Novena and Social following the 12 o'clock mass. This is a great feast for our Filipino Community and I encourage all to attend because we all know how important it is to be proud of our heritage.

Today at 3:00 pm, our regional Bishop, celebrate a special mass in honor of San Lorenzo Ruiz at the Cathedral Basilica of the Sacred Heart in Newark. The principal celebrant of this mass will be Archbishop Bernardito Auza, Papal Nuncio and Permanent Observer of the Vatican at the United Nations.
