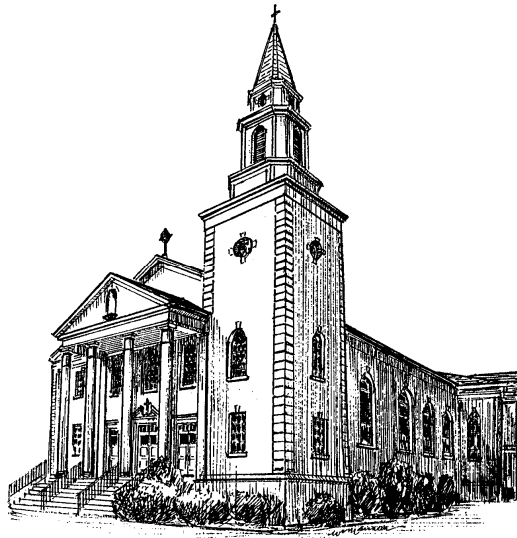

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process by which adults (and children who have reached the age of reason) are prepared to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. If you, or someone you know, would like to inquire about becoming a Catholic, please call the parish office.

Ministry to the Sick and Homebound

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is available to be celebrated with anyone in need. Please do not wait until death is imminent to contact the parish regarding an ill family member. Eucharistic Ministers and others serve our community by visiting and bringing Communion to the sick and homebound. Please call the parish office if you wish such a visit.

ARE YOU REGISTERED?

We have people coming to St. Mary's on a regular basis who need a form of some kind filled out and, when we check our records, we find that they are not registered parishioners. Before we could fill out and sign the form, you have to be a registered active parishioner for at **least six months**. The best way to know that you are registered is the fact that you receive collection envelopes, either on a regular basis or only at Christmas or Easter.

PLEASE – save yourselves and the parish staff a great deal of time and trouble – **come to the rectory office and register!**

Last Sunday, St. Mary's was blessed to have Bishop John Flesey with us as 79 young members of our parish received the sacrament of Confirmation. I'd like to thank Bishop Flesey for being with us for what was a truly wonderful celebration. I also thank our newly confirmed youngsters for their witness of faith.

The Bishop is the ordinary minister of the Sacrament of Confirmation however there are times when the pastor becomes the minister of the sacrament. At the Easter Vigil, those Catechumens who have completed their instruction through the RCIA program receive all three Sacraments of Initiation; Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist from the presider of the mass.

Also, a pastor may request Delegation from the regional bishop to confirm baptized Catholic adults who have prepared to complete the Sacraments of Initiation through the RCIA program. This delegation is only granted during the Easter season.

When a baptized adult from another faith tradition wants to become Catholic; what the Church calls entering into Full Communion with the Catholic Church, the laws of the Church (Canon Law), give a pastor automatic delegation to minister the Sacrament of Confirmation. This Sunday, at the 7:45 am mass, we will welcome one young woman into the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Eucharist. It is a great privilege to be the minister of the Sacrament of Confirmation as we welcome her into the Catholic Church and into our parish. I ask that we all pray for her as she begins her life as a Catholic as part of our community of faith.
