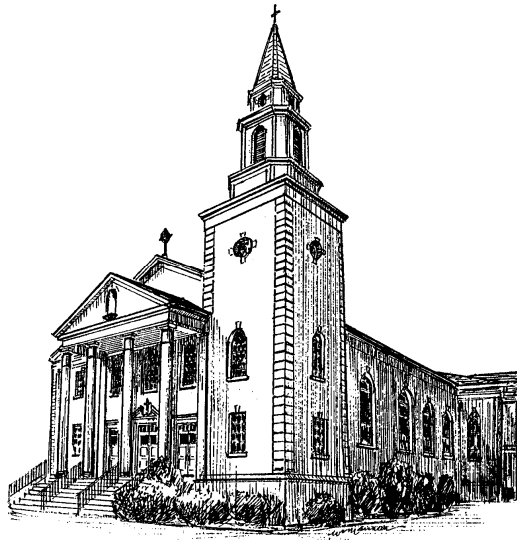

## **Catechumenate**

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process by which adults (and children who have reached the age of reason) are prepared to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. If you, or someone you know, would like to inquire about becoming a Catholic, please call the parish office.

## From the Pastor

Each year, every parish in the diocese is asked to participate in the Co-operative Mission Appeal. This weekend, our parish welcomes Fr. Boniface from the Archdioceses of Monrovia in Liberia. Liberia, on the west coast of Africa, is Africa's first and oldest modern republic and its constitution and its flag were modeled after those of the U.S. The Republic of Liberia traces its history to settlements of freed American slaves. Its capital, Monrovia, is named in honor of U.S. President James Monroe.

While the majority of Liberians are Christian, the percentage of Catholics in Liberia is relatively small. Fr. Boniface will talk about the challenges of building up the Catholic Church in a very ethnically diverse nation.

While few of us will ever be called to serve as missionaries for Christ, supporting those who do say "Yes" to this special calling is the responsibility of every Christian. Jesus told his disciples to preach the Good News to all nations. This can only happen with your help. This weekend a special collection will be taken to support the work of Fr. Boniface and his community. I ask you to prayerfully consider your support for this weekend's Mission Appeal.

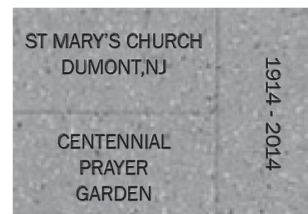
