

# From Deacon John Sylvester

Poverty, especially extreme poverty, is something that is generally associated with countries such as Bangladesh, Ethiopia or Nepal. But poverty has been growing right here in the United States and right here in Bergen County.

Parishioners of St. Mary's assist those in our community who live in very difficult circumstances. Many people are one paycheck away from having to choose to pay the rent or purchase food, so in the basement of the church is the food pantry that assists those so they don't have to choose to go homeless or hungry.

For families that have no place to call home, Family Promise provides food and shelter. Typically there is a working mother or father with several children. Many religious congregations support this effort, including St. Mary's. Three times a year parishioners prepare dinner for those families and joins them in the meal. Some of them stay overnight to take care of any needs that might arise, and provide the fixings for breakfast and lunch that the families take with them. All families are required to leave the building for the day.

In addition to providing for their immediate needs, Family Promise assists the families in finding permanent homes.

Once a month parishioners travel to St. John's church in Newark. No longer a parish, at this historic building meals are provided for over 100 homeless people six days a week. Once a month St. Mary's parishioners serve the food.

Closer to home, in Hackensack Family Promise operates a walk-in shelter that serves about 120 people every day. The aluminum pans you see in church about every four months is for parishioners to use to prepare their best dish. It is then heated in the Knights of Columbus building and brought to the shelter and served by parishioners. The recipients are very grateful and frequently state that St. Mary's brings the best food and has the largest variety.

Asked why she does this, one parishioner said, "I feel called to help someone in need. Giving back for all the blessings in my life." Another stated that this gives him a glimpse into "part of a forgotten world."

None of these efforts will solve the crisis of poverty, but it does make a difference to those we serve. And it makes a difference to us.
