

If you, or someone you know, would like to inquire about becoming a Catholic, please call the parish office.

#### Ministry to the Sick and Homebound

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is available to be celebrated with anyone in need. Please do not wait until death is imminent to contact the parish regarding an ill family member. Eucharistic Ministers and others serve our community by visiting and bringing Communion to the sick and homebound. Please call the parish office if you wish such a visit.

This Friday, September 28th, the Catholic Church will celebrate the feast day of San Lorenzo Ruiz, the patron saint of the Philippines. In the 17th century, San Lorenzo and his companions were martyred during a Japanese persecution of Christians. San Lorenzo willingly died rather than recant his faith in Christ. San Lorenzo is the protomartyr and first saint of the Philippines.

Today, the Filipino Community of St. Mary's will celebrate San Lorenzo Ruiz with a Novena and Social following the 12 o'clock mass. This is a great feast for our Filipino Community and I encourage all to attend because we all know how important it is to be proud of our heritage.


