

In 1918, in the 11<sup>th</sup> hour of the 11<sup>th</sup> day of the 11<sup>th</sup> month, the Armistice that brought an end to World War I was formally signed. The following year, President Woodrow Wilson declared November 11<sup>th</sup> to be "Armistice Day" to honor all those who had served our nation in "The War to End All Wars".

Sadly, more wars followed and in 1954, President Dwight Eisenhower signed an Act of Congress that changed Armistice Day into Veterans Day to honor all the men and women who have served in the armed forces of our nation. This weekend, as we observe Veterans Day, let us pause and say a prayer of thanks for all those who have served and special prayer for those currently serving in war torn areas of our world.

All too often, we take for granted the freedoms our country guarantees us. We need to remember that this would not be possible if men and women of each generation had not been willing to accept the call to serve in the Armed Forces.
