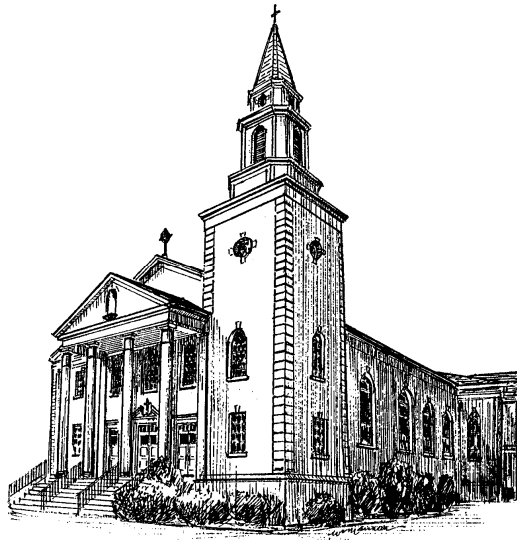

In 1918, in the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month, the Armistice that brought an end to World War I was formally signed. The following year, President Woodrow Wilson declared November 11th to be "Armistice Day" to honor all those who had served our nation in "The War to End All Wars".

Sadly, more wars followed and in 1954, President Dwight Eisenhower signed an Act of Congress that changed Armistice Day into Veterans Day to honor all the men and women who have served in the armed forces of our nation. This weekend, as we observe Veterans Day, let us pause and say a prayer of thanks for all those who have served and special prayer for those currently serving in war torn areas of our world.

All too often, we take for granted the freedoms our country guarantees us. 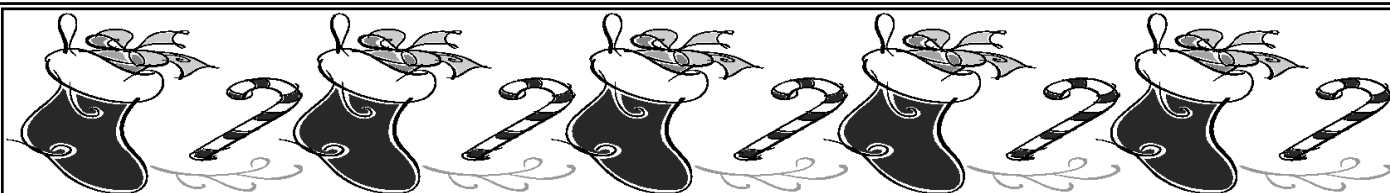
