

From the Pastor

When many of us were children, almost every Catholic Church had a Catholic School. I fear those days are long gone. So many Catholic schools, like St. Mary's, closed years ago. When St. Mary's School closed, it joined with St. John's in Bergenfield and The Church of the Ascension in New Milford to form the co-sponsored school, Transfiguration Academy.

In recent years, the Archdiocese of Newark has abandoned the co-sponsorship model and now almost all catholic grammar school in the Archdiocese are under the direct authority of Archdiocesan School's Office. While this may mean that St. Mary's no longer has an official role in Transfiguration Academy, we still work to support it and we strongly encourage parishioners to consider it when making decisions about the education of their children.

Some things about Catholic schools have not changed, most importantly, the quality of the education they provide. Transfiguration Academy provides a superior education that is balanced with strong moral development and an emphasis on spiritual growth. Transfiguration Academy has been acknowledged as a National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence.

To celebrate this special recognition as a Blue Ribbon School, our Archbishop, Cardinal Tobin, will kick-off Catholic Schools Week by celebrating the 12 noon mass at St. John's in Bergenfield with the Transfiguration Academy community.

Catholic Schools Week is a wonderful chance to celebrate the many ways in which Catholic schools contribute to our Church and our community. Again, I encourage all those with school-aged children to consider Transfiguration Academy and encourage everyone to support the values of a Catholic education.



<u>Book Discussion Group Planned</u> <u>For the New Year</u>

Our Archbishop, Cardinal Joseph Tobin, has said "In too many parts of our church LGBT people have been made to feel unwelcome, excluded, and even shamed." A recent book by James Martin, SJ, Building a Bridge: How the Catholic Church and LGBT Community Can Enter Into a Relationship of Respect, Compassion, and Sensitivity, has



become a controversial book within and outside the church. Why? At St Mary's we would like to explore that simple question in a series of three (3) sessions, which would involve reading the book and attending sessions on three consecutive Wednesday evenings, January 30, February 6, and February 13th at 7:30 PM in the Parish Office (located in the rear of the rectory). All are welcome!

World Day for Consecrated Life



In 1997, Pope Saint John Paul II instituted a day of prayer to celebrate women and men in consecrated life. Since then the universal Church celebrates World Day for Consecrated Life on February 2nd. This celebration is attached to the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. This Feast is also know as Candelmas Day; the day on which candles are blessed symbolizing Christ who is the light of the world. So too, those in consecrated life are called to reflect the light of Jesus Christ to all peoples.

The consecrated life is one way that men and women live out their baptismal commitment as followers of Jesus. Religious sisters, nun, brothers, religious priests, and monks consecrate their lives through their profession of the evangelical vows and live as part of a community.
