<u>Old Palms Wanted</u>



Book Discussion Group Building a Bridge

Our Archbishop, Cardinal Joseph Tobin, has said "In too many parts of our church LGBT people have been made to feel unwelcome, excluded, and even shamed." A recent book by James Martin, SJ, Building a Bridge: How the Catholic Church and LGBT Community Can Enter Into a Relationship of Respect, Compassion, and Sensitivity, has become a controversial book within and outside the church. Why? At St Mary's we continue to explore that simple question in the third of three sessions this Wednesday, February 13th at 7:30 PM in the Spiritual Formation Center (in the school building). All are welcome!
