Today, we kick off National Vocation Awareness Week; an annual, week-long celebration of the Catholic Church in the United States dedicated to promoting vocations to ordained ministry and consecrated life through prayer and education. It also reminds us to renew our prayers and support for those who are in the seminary or in formation and for those who are considering one of these particular vocations.

Observance of Vocation Awareness Week began in 1976 when the U.S. bishops designated the 28th Sunday of the year for the celebration. It was later moved to the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord in January. In 2014, after extensive consultation, the Committee on Clergy, Consecrated Life and Vocations moved the observance of National Vocation Awareness Week to November to engage Catholic schools and colleges more effectively in this effort.

The call to serve as an ordained minister or the call to consecrated life must come from God but amid the noise and confusion of our world, this call is sometimes hard to hear. As a parish, we must pray that those called will hear and joyfully respond to God's invitation to serve. We must be a parish that encourages and supports to those who say yes to God's call.
