This coming Friday, January 24th, thousands will march in Washington to mark the anniversary of the 1973 Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision which legalized abortion in this country. All those who march give profound witness to our belief that life begins at conception and that all human life is a precious gift from God.

In the past few years, many states have worked to establish laws to limit access to abortion as a means of negating the Roe v Wade decision. Many hope that the Supreme Court will overturn their decision and abortion will again become illegal.

It is important to remember that abortion in this country did not start with Roe v Wade and abortions will not end if the laws are changed. As important as it is to change laws, it is much more important to changed hearts and minds. Until everyone acknowledges the sanctity of all human life, from conception to natural death, abortions in this country will continue.

I find it extremely ironic that at the same time people work to enact laws to stop abortions, others work to promote laws that permit physician assisted suicide, euthanasia and the death penalty. If we want to claim the mantle of Pro-Life, we must respect and protect all human life.

For those who can not join the marcher in Washington let us pray that God will protect them on their journey. Let us pray for lawmakers that they will enact laws to respect and protect all human life. Let us pray for those who are confronting a crisis pregnancy and seriously considering an abortion. Let us pray for those who have had an abortion that they may turn to God for his mercy and healing love.

For those who in need of post-abortion healing, the Catholic Church has a wonderful program called Project Rachel. Project Rachel Retreats are given in the Archdiocese of Newark but some individuals may be hesitant to attend fearing the embarrassment of meeting someone they know. One of my cousins works with the Project Rachel Retreat program in the Diocese of Trenton. Below is a notice she sent me about an upcoming retreat

As a pro-life people, our hearts ache for the millions of babies lost to abortion. However, little is heard about the tremendous emotional pain, regret and crippling remorse that many women and men experience following an abortion. These parents are also victims of a culture of death. They suffer a traumatic wound, with consequences that can last a lifetime. As a pro-life people, our hearts ache for them, too. Rachel's Vineyard is a weekend retreat that offers these wounded parents an opportunity to walk with Christ through the complex circumstances that led to abortion, as well as the devastating aftermath. Rachel's Vineyard also provides a blessed opportunity for parents to begin processing their grief, and to memorialize their children. There is no judgement. There is just an atmosphere of fellowship, compassion, and healing. If an abortion is impacting you, please remember that our merciful Father in Heaven loves you, just as much as He loves your child.
