

LOURDES HYMN Arranged by Josh Blakesley





who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets.


I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church.

I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.



you have looked upon your servant, you have visited your people.




Verses 2-5

- 5. In your love you now fulfill what you promised to your people. I will praise you Lord, my savior, everlasting is your mercy.


