



- The voice of the LORD is over the waters, the LORD, over vast waters.


The voice of the LORD is mighty; the voice of the LORD is majestic.

who proceeds from the Father and the Son,


who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets.

I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.




