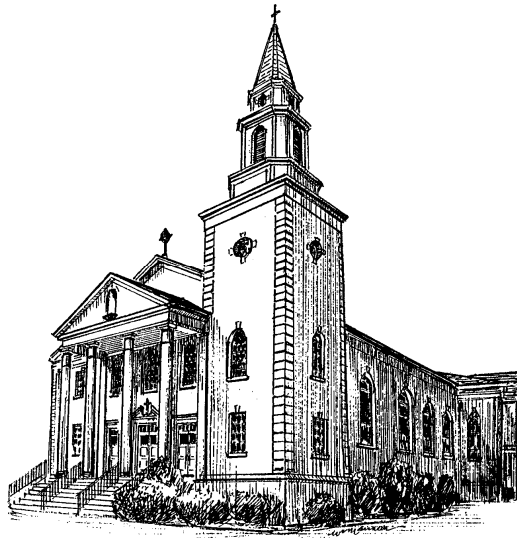

### **Confirmation Virtual Session 2/7/22 at 7:00 p.m.**

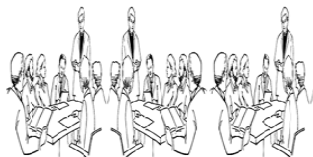
